- Ticket prices are: \$20 for single ticket or \$50 six-ticket package (only for senior families)
- Advance ticket sale starts on Monday, May 11 for senior families
- General reservations: May 18 through May 26 or whenever tickets sell-out
- All sales are final and nonrefundable
- Tickets are paperless. Your name will appear on a "paid" list at the door.

Questions and Answers

Q: I understand the show is general seating. When do the doors open?

A: It will be announced closer to the event. They will be opened early enough to ensure everyone is seated by 7:45 pm. Please check zipNotes, eNotes, or the Senior News web page as we get closer to the event.

Q: Will there be food and drinks before the show?

A: No, but there will be refreshments after the show. Additionally, please do not bring food and drinks into the Athletic Center. Water is okay.

Q: Is there a party after the show? Can we all come?

A: There will be an after party following the evening show in the West Gym where refreshments are served while you celebrate with the seniors and the rest of the Menlo community. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Q: We bought a senior family package and our extended families will be arriving separately. Do we need to check-in together?

A: No, you do not need to check-in together. The check-in desk will keep track of the number of family members as they check in.

Q: My senior's 90-year old grandma is coming and won't be able to climb bleachers. Will there be seating for elderly and handicapped at the floor level?

A: Yes, of course. We will have a few folding chairs available on the floor. We will designate an area for wheelchairs. Please inform Ruby Seidl if you have guests who need these accommodations.

Q: I can't make the evening show and I really would love to see the show. Is there an afternoon performance?

A: Yes, there is a 2:00 pm show that is scheduled as an Upper School assembly to accommodate students, faculty and staff. You may choose to join at no charge, just contact <u>Ruby Seidl</u>. There are no refreshments after the 2:00 pm show.

Q: Can my senior's Middle School sibling join to see the afternoon show?

A: The Middle School has its own year-end activities schedule at that time. S/he is welcomed to attend the evening show with the family.
